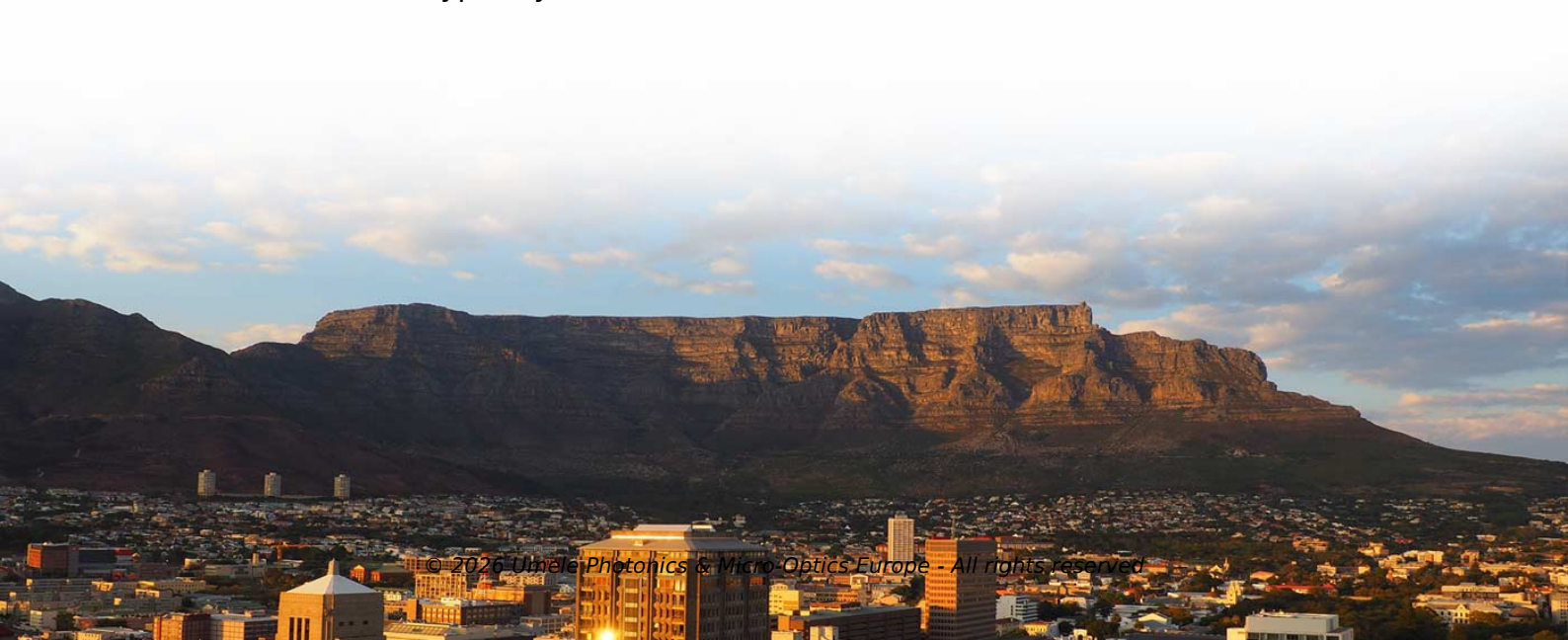

Despite representing less than 1% of total fiber infrastructure cost, they account for 30-40% of all fiber network faults in enterprise and data.
