Future Expansion: Leave extra space around the box for potential upgrades or additional wiring. Modular terminal blocks benefit from extra room for adding circuits without major rework .

Safety and Labeling: Clearly label all wires and terminals, and follow electrical codes and standards (e.g., UL 508A for industrial panels). Proper labeling and spacing reduce the risk of shorts, shocks, and troubleshooting errors .
